EAC had implemented some small programmes of Government in the past.

- i. One Work Camp for Youth with the support of Nehru Yuva Kendra, Churachandpur amounting to a meager amount of Rs.15,000/
- ii. School Sanitary Toilet under Total Sanitation programme for 15 schools with the support of PHED, Churachandpur, Govt. of Manipur with amount of Rs. 11,50,000/-
- iii. Regional Seminar on Environmental Issues for the whole North East India states in collaboration with Indira Gandhi National Tribal University, Imphal supported by North East Council, Govt. of India amounting to Rs. 400,000/-

ii. Government programmes/schemes being implemented presently.

- The Promotion and Support of Women Self Help Groups project is being implemented by Evangelical Assembly Church in three blocks namely Tipaimukh, Singngat and Churachandpur, of Churachandpur District, Manipur since June, 2012 with the support of NABARD under Women SHG Scheme of the Government of India. Its main purpose is to promote self-help initiatives for self-reliance and promote gender equity and finance inclusion. The sanctioned amount is Rs. 20,00,000/-
- A Rural Mart run by Sharon SHG at EAC Complex, Rengkai Road with the support of NABARD was facilitated by Evangelical Assembly Church. The main aim of the Rural Mart is providing sustainable marketing facility for SHGs, Farmer's Clubs and individual entrepreneurs for their finished products. The sanctioned amount for is Rs. 107,500/-
